* On the right side click BROWSE EBOOKS NONFICTION, then click View All "Travel"

Week #12 Tour: * In the gold bar at the top, click [Electronic Resources](#).
* Scroll down to NoveList. (Resources are listed alphabetically.)
* Click the  icon if you are at home; click **H** icon if you are at the Library.
* Enter your Library card number when prompted.
* On the right side under **NovelList Resources** click [Author Read-Alikes](#).

- Week #12 Vacation Destination:** * What place inspires Isabel Allende's works?
AND
* Click [Isabel Allende](#). Which similar author is a man?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: On our main page, click [Book and Media Lists](#). Under [Booklists for Adults](#) you will find titles chosen by Librarians for fans of Memoirs, Anita Shreve, fiction about art, and many more.

Week # 11: August 8 – 14: InterLibrary Loans

**What happens if you want to read a book that Hunterdon County Library doesn't own?
We borrow it for you from another library outside the county. Here's how:**

- Week #11 Tour:** * In the left column, under [Not at HCL?](#) click [Interlibrary Loan](#).
* Click [Submit your request to JerseyCat directly](#).
* Type [Jersey Cat](#) into the search box.

- Week #11 Vacation Destination:** * What is the first title on the list that has the name of a state in it?
* What is the title of the story in that book that includes a Cat?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: Read the Interlibrary Loan FAQs. Think of a book you read long ago, or would like to read, and see if JerseyCat has it. ILL it if you like – be sure to check our catalog first!

Week # 10: August 1 – 7: World Atlas

Let's get started: * Start at the Library's main webpage www.hclibrary.us

- Week #10 Tour:** * In the left column, under [Research](#) click [Electronic Resources](#).
* In the printed column on the left, click [History & Geography](#).
* Scroll down to the World Atlas 
* Click the [H](#) if you are in the library; click the little [house](#) if you are at home.
* Enter your library card number when prompted.

- Week #10 Vacation Destination:** * Click the arrow beside to open a list of countries.
* 5 countries have names divided by "and".
* Which is NOT an island? **AND** Which is near Africa?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: Pick a country you like and peruse its' [People and Culture](#), [History](#), and other fascinating facts from the list on the left. Or, under Compare and Rank select a statistic like [GDP](#) or [Infant Mortality Rate](#) or [Telephone Lines](#). Click [Go](#) and choose some countries to compare.

Week # 9: July 25 – 31: Antiques

Let's get started: * Start at the Library's main webpage www.hclibrary.us

- Week #9 Tour:** * In the left column, under [Research](#) click [Electronic Resources](#).
* **Scroll down the alphabetical list of resources to p4a: Prices for Antiques.**
* Click the [H](#) if you are in the library; click the little [house](#) if you are at home.
* Enter your library card number when prompted.
* Click the [icon](#).

- Week #9 Vacation Destination:** * Type Zimbabwe into the Key Word(s) box and click Search.
* One item is perfect for our Reading Club theme. Click on it.
* What is it made of **AND** which tribe does it depict?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: Search for your favorite collectible or antique treasures by typing different words into the Key Word(s) box, and by selecting a different Category, Type or Origin from the drop-down boxes.

Week #8 Tour: * In the right column, under **What's New...** click **Required Summer Reading.**

Week # 5: June 27 – July 4: Languages

Let's get started: * Start at the Library's main webpage www.hclibrary.us

* On the left column, under **Research**, click **Electronic Resources**.

Week #5 Tour: * E-Resources are listed alphabetically. Scroll down to **Powerspeak Languages**.

* Click on the house if you are at home OR click on the **H** if you are at the Library.

* Scroll down the list of languages on the left, examining the picture for each.

Week #5 Vacation Destination: * Which language's picture shows a modern mode of transportation?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: Click on each the name of each language to see some important words. Can you find a word in one of these mini-lessons, for something you'd find in a library? Choose any language and learn a few words or phrases.

* On the gold bar near the top of the page, click **Branches**

Week #3 Vacation Destination: * What is the mural in the children's room and who does it honor?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: Discover the history of all the Hunterdon County libraries in "About Us": when the county began library service (Bookmobile); which town has had a library since 1799; a library building in a former train station; and other fascinating facts. You can also check out the summer programs at each library.

* In the left column under **Research**, click ***Jobs and Career Links**

Week #2 Tour: * Under **Gateways to Job and Career Sites**, click ***Quintessential Careers**

* Under **Top Job Categories** (center column, bottom) click ***Job Search-UK Jobs**

* Click the **Jobs by Location** tab; then click the **B** tab.

Week #2 Vacation Destination: * How many jobs are listed for the resort city of Bath?

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK: On the ***Jobs and Career Links** page, under **Career Assessment Resources** click **Job & Career Accelerator** for tutorials and practice tests including CDL, Citizenship, Civil Service, computer programs, Firefighter, GED, math and reading skills, SAT, TOEFL, TOEIC and many more.

Week # 1: May 30 – June 5: the OnLine Catalog

Let's get started: * Start at the Library's main webpage www.hclibrary.us
* Click on OnLine Catalog in the gold bar.

Week #1 Tour: * In the "Keyword Search by Any Field" mode, type **passport**.
* Find the book by Nathaniel Lande.
* On the right, opposite the title, click on the word **Summary**

Week #1 Vacation Destination: * What will readers find in the second half of this book?
