In 2007, Jim Murphy became the first inductee from the Garden State into "The Old Time Country Music Hall of Fame." In April, 2008, Jim's efforts on behalf of traditional country music were acknowledged by Rutgers, The State University, at the New Jersey Folk Festival when Jim was presented with the "Lifetime Achievement Award".
